Notice Of Race



1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the most recent racing rules of sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association, the by-laws and appendices of the Comet Class Yacht Racing Association (CCYRA) and the Sailing Instructions. (Anchor & line, paddle, and PFD's are required per CCYRA Specifications, Section 16.) The latest RRS may be found at:

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A as stated in ISAF Regulation 20.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

This event is open to CCYRA members who have <u>paid their 2016 dues</u>. Eligible yachts may be entered by mailing (*post date no later than 05-Jun-2016*) the attached FULLY COMPLETED <u>Official Entry Form</u> and <u>Waiver and Release of Liability Form</u> to: Andy Wood, 226 Harbor Lane, Queenstown, MD 21658. Late entries may be given to an on-site registration official at SSA during the registration time periods <u>with</u> <u>the additional late fee</u>. Call or e-mail Andy Wood for more registration information at 410-310-9374, woodhaus226@gmail.com. All checks are to be made payable to CCYRA.

4. ENTRY FEE

The <u>CCYRA 2016 North American Championship Regatta</u> entry fee is \$110 plus a \$15 late fee if applicable. This includes registration fee, a continental breakfast Sat & Sun, and lunches on the water Sat & Sun for skippers and crew as well as dinner Saturday night at SSA. Regatta trophies will be awarded to top 5 finishes for skipper and crew. Checks are to be made payable to CCYRA and mailed to Andy Wood, 226 Harbor Lane, Queenstown, MD 21658. Mailing postmarked after 4-Jun-2016 must include the late fee.

5. SAIL MEASUREMENT

During the registration period all sails may be subjected to measurement and checking for CCYRA Sail Tax Labels. [If you need Sail Tax Labels, contact Dave Seifert (614) 457-3094.]

6. BOAT WEIGHT VERIFICATION

During the Friday registration period boats may be weighed at the owner's discretion if a scale is available to determine an official weight as observed by Dick Harmon, Brad Meade, or Talbott Ingram. Weights may then be recorded and sent to the Comet class as an official record.

All times above are approximate as the Comet Class will be participating as a guest Class with the Snipe Junior Class Championships and sharing the same race course.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available during check-in on the first day of racing. The Comet class will be following the Snipe Class International Association sailing instructions for conducting national and international championship regattas with an addendum attached for Comet eligibility.

9. VENUE

Severn Sailing Association - Two heavy duty lifts are available on site. Boats may be kept on-site and on your trailer during the event. Parking is extremely limited and the Club requires double and triple parking inside the entrance. Your keys must be left in the car in case your car needs to be moved to allow someone to leave. The sailing will likely be in the Chesapeake Bay between Greenbury Point and Tolly Point off the entrance to Annapolis. The Annapolis Performace Sailing retail store is just around the corner and is open Friday from 9am-6pm and Saturday/Sunday from 9am-5pm.

10. THE COURSE

The course options shall be provided in the Sailing Instructions

11. SCORING

One (1) race will constitute a series; if six (6) or more races are sailed, each yacht's poorest finish will be discarded. [Sailing Instructions will be provided at the Registration Desk.]

12. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats.



13. REQUIRED SAFETY EQUIPMENT

U.S. competitors shall carry a U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) approved personal floatation device (PFD). Competitors from outside the U.S. shall carry a PFD approved by their nations' certification authority to the extent permitted by international treaty.

CCYRA Specified: All boats shall carry a paddle and a minimum 4lb anchor with 50 ft. line per CCYRA specifications, Section 16.

14. PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

No competitor shall use, either on or off the water: marijuana or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 U.S. Code 802) the possession of which is unlawful under 21 U.S. Code 841. No competitor, member of the race committee, or member of the safety patrol shall use alcohol during racing. The consumption of alcohol by competitors under age 21 is strictly prohibited both on and off the water during the entire event.

An alleged breach of one of these regulations shall not be grounds for a protest. However, when the protest committee believes that a competitor may have breached one of these regulations, it shall follow the process described in racing rule 69.1 and a competitor found to have breached one of these regulations shall be excluded from the remaining races in the series, and where practical removed from the regatta venue and sent home. The competitor's boat shall be disqualified from all races of the series.

15. AWARDS

Regatta trophies: Awarded to top five (5) skippers and crew

Perpetual trophies: Comet Class North American Championship Trophy

16. SOCIAL

Friday arrival: Welcome beer keg will be provided Friday evening to competitors.

Breakfasts: Continental breakfasts will be provided Saturday & Sunday to competitors.

Lunches: Bag lunches will be provided Saturday and Sunday to competitors. **Saturday dinner:** Dinner will be served upstairs at SSA promptly at 6:30pm.
